



If one does not have SAVING FAITH, one does not have the gift of salvation, i.e., GOD did not give one the gift that is in Eph 2:8-9. Cf. Acts 13:48; John 10:27; John 10:26-29; John 12:40; Rom 11:7; 2 Co 3:14. "Believe on the Lord Jesus Christ" for salvation is a COMMAND: Acts 13:48 (Grace gives the gift of salvation and faith receives it, Eph 2:8-9). The elect obey God.

After one "hears" with saving faith (the WORD mixed with FAITH), one believes, repents, and turns to God (FAITH BELIEVING). Sanctification is the process of setting the believer apart from the world. The Holy Spirit does this. His work of sanctification continues until the believer gets his glorified body. (cf. EZEK 36:26-27 A new heart also will I give you, and a new spirit will I put within you: and I will take away the stony heart out of your flesh, and I will give you an heart of flesh. And I will put my spirit within you, and cause you to walk in my statutes, and ye shall keep my judgments, and do them. (Believers obey God.)

After one believes the gospel, repents, and converts, one learns to trust Christ (grows spiritually). Cf. John 3:16: For God so loved the world that he gave his only begotten son that whosoever believeth (English believing) in (English into Him) him shall not perish but have (present tense) everlasting life. Once one trusts Christ. he receives Him, John 1:12 (Indwelling of the Holy Spirit) (cf.http://biblehub.com/greek /2983.htm). Scripture says that new life is in Christ, 2 Co 5:17. Christ baptizes the believer into the Holy Spirit, John 1:33; 1 Cor 12:13, "Baptism of the Holy Spirit". Baptism means to be placed into. Believers are placed into Christ via the Spirit baptism. Christ baptizes them with the Holy Spirit (The agent of baptism) (Note: all the words pertaining to salvation in this chart are different with different meanings.) Salvation is a process that begins in eternity past and ends in eternity future. This is one salvation, Rom 8:30, Eph 2:1-10. PHIL 1:6 Being confident of this very thing, that he which hath begun a good work in you will perform it until the day of Jesus Christ; PHIL 2:12-13 Wherefore, my beloved, as ye have always obeyed, not as in my presence only, but now much more in my absence, work out your own salvation with fear and trembling. For it is God which worketh in you both to will and to do of his good pleasure. The Just shall live by faith, Rom 1:17.
